Access to re-enter the system is basically non-existent as the government and the private sector have invested in the idea of extended access using the brick and mortar access approach. ELearning, as of now has not been a viable solution. ELearning, as described and mandated by the Philippine congress has fallen off the foreseeable map sometime around 2005 and 2006.
